CONSTRUCTION PHASES

Phase 1: Permitting: We apply for all permits required by your parish. The lead time varies depending on your location.

Phase 2: LA One Call: Utilities like water, power lines, and gas are marked with spray paint. So we know to avoid them!

Phase 3: Layout- The week you are scheduled to dig we will layout your design in the exact shape, size, and location.

Phase 4: Excavation- Time to dig! Typically we will have your pool dug in one day.

Phase 5: Steel/Plumbing/Electrical- A few days after your pool is dug we will begin working on reinforcing the structure of your pool with steel and installing the plumbing along with electrical.

Phase 6: Gunite - The gunite is sprayed onto the steel creating a shell.

**Remember the gunite will need to be watered down twice a day for ten days in order to cure

Phase 7: Tile and Coping- Your waterline tile and coping are installed. Be sure you have met with your designer to make your material selections!

Step 8: Decking- We will lay your deck out according to plan.

- o If you are getting a paver deck, we will lay a base of sand & limestone. We will let this settle and compact.
- o If Sundek is chosen, it will need to cure for a week.

Phase 9: Plaster-We apply waterproof pool interior finish. As soon as the plaster is complete, you can add water. Be sure to brush your pool daily for the next 14 days, then backing off once a week.

Phase 10: Final Clean-up & Start-up — We will clean up any debris, scraps, or material left on site. For the next 30 days, we will take care of chemicals ensuring that everything is adjusted correctly.

Phase 11: Pool School – 30 days after start-up we will come to you to teach you how to use and take care of your pool. Once you have aced the course, the pool is for you to enjoy!
